

COURSE TITLE: COMMERCIAL FOOD PROCESSING

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Though agriculture sector contributes substantially to the country's GDP, some of sub-sectors, such as food processing and value addition remain underdeveloped. Among other reasons to this sad situation is limited capacity by farmers to process and add value to agricultural produce for the markets. This course is, therefore, aimed at providing practical skills to farmers and agro-food processors in processing of various food products. Specifically, the course will focus on processing fruits, soybeans, and groundnuts into high value food products (such as dried fruits, fruit juices, fruit jam and fruit yoghurt; soymilk, soy yoghurt, soy butter and okara, roasted peanut and peanut butter).

TARGET PARTICIPANTS:

Youths with a strong passion in commercial food processing; Enterprising Women; Existing Food Processors; Farmer Cooperatives; Professionals with passion in Food Processing; Extension Workers.

COURSE DURATION: 5 Weeks

DELIVERY MODE: Blended Approach (Face-to-Face Orientation and Facilitation and 4 Weeks online learning)

KEY COMPETENCIES

- Ability to process dried fruits, jam, peanut butter, soy milk, soy yoghurt and dairy yoghurt.
- Conscientiousness in food safety and hygiene practices during processing of food products.
- c) Identification of viable food processing enterprises.
- d) Development and management of food processing enterprises.

INDICATIVE COURSE CONTENT: Market Analysis and Identification of viable Food Processing Enterprises; Commercial Fruit Processing; Commercial Jam Production; Commercial Yoghurt Production; Market-oriented Soy Processing; Profitable Peanut Butter Production; Management of Quality in Food Processing Business; Marketing of Processed Food Products.

COURSE FEE: MWK180,000.00 per participant
